WHAT IS SO SPECIAL ABOUT OUR SEATTLE SHUTTERS?

- The primary material of Seattle shutters is Engineered Wood, also known as MDF (Medium-Density Fibreboard); this composite wood is structured together internally with Laminated Veneer Lumber (LVL), strong and hard wearing strips of wood bonded together to form a rigid core, so you know that the stability of your shutters is unquestionable and are twist and warp resistant.
- The Engineered Wood of Seattle shutters is coated with a Polypropylene (PP) coating, which is available in 6 on-trend colour choices to match the style of your home perfectly. This coating also provides extra protection against scratching, chipping and staining. The UV inhibitors in the coating also resists yellowing, so you know that your shutters will not be affected over time.
- The louvres in these shutters move in unison with the Easy Tilt louvre drive system, done so without the use of a tilt rod. This optional gear driven system can be built into each side panel and operates with precision to ensure the ultimate light control. Tilt rods are also available in all styles.
- Seattle shutters are covered by a comprehensive 3 year warranty for extra peace of mind.
